

Security Pack Installation Guide

Thank you for choosing the **Wiener&Bun Security Pack** !

The **Wiener&Bun** Password manager will help any user of a server to store and manage their password in the most secure and easy-to-use way ! The **Wiener&Bun** way !

This short guide will give you the main guidelines to properly install your Security Storage Server.

IMPORTANT NOTE : You must NOT keep this file on your server, as it contains many critical informations about how the passwords are stored.

1 – Installation

Deploy **install_security.exe** on the root folder of your file system. Execute the program, it will automatically create all the folders and system files. Do not create, modify or delete any files during the installation.

2 - Security Folder

After the installation, the '**Security**' folder will be created on the root of your file system. It's a hidden file, it won't be listed and can only be accessed by typing its name on the address bar of your file explorer.

We recommend you to not mess with the content of this folder.

3 – Passwords

When a crypted folder is added to the server, the password is automatically stored in the security file, and encrypted (see **File encryption** segment for more informations).

Then, it can be easily retrieved using the **Wiener&Bun** Password Retrieved (not included).

4 – File encryption

When a password is stored, it is divided into four files. The reading sequence of the files is randomized each time, and encrypted (If you have the **Wiener&Bun** Encryption Generator (not included)).

ATTENTION : In the eventuality of a malfunction of the password manager, the order of the file can be retrieved for an emergency protocol. The order is secretely written on an imag[REST OF THE DOCUMENT UNAVAILABLE]
